PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Munich city centre's public transport system (MVV) runs from around 05:00 to 1:00 daily. Tickets, which are valid for all types are available from machines by the platforms, or at the MVV centre on the first floor of the Munich Central Station (Hauptbahnhof), which is open daily from 06:00 to 24:00. Also note that during the exhibition, your bauma entrance ticket will provide free travel on the Underground to and from the showground.

If you are planning more than two short rides in a day, then a day ticket is good value, and there are two types: the Individual, and the Partner for up to five people (2 children from 6-14 years count as one person). Prices range from €4.50 to €18.50, depending on whether you are travelling within the city centre (Innenraum) or the outskirts (Außenraum, including the airport) or both. A three-day pass for the city centre only is also available, while a weekly

Isarcard, from €9.50, is available from ticket machines and MVV sales points in many stations.

The Welcome Card is a public transport ticket that also offers reduced entrance fees to various sights and museums around Munich. Single tickets can be bought from the driver on the many buses and trams. Multiple tickets that are also valid for the U-Bahn and S-Bahn, however, must be bought from the vending machines.

TAXIS

Taxis in and around Munich are mostly all cream-coloured BMWs and Mercedes, which can be flagged down in the street, found at a rank, or ordered by calling a Zentrale. The basic fare is around €2.60 (add €1 for pre-booked), plus €1.20 to €1.45 for each kilometre. However, Taxis charge a standardized rate of €48 for a direct ride to the show ground. The two main firms are Isarfunk tel: 45 05 40 and Taxi München tel: 216 10.

AIRPORT

Munich's Franz Joseph Strauß Airport is about 40 kilometres north of Munich city centre. To get there, the fastest and cheapest way is to take the S-Bahn lines S1 or S8, which depart from underneath the Central Area at the airport. Tickets can be purchased from dispensers or from the ticket counter and must be validated before descending to the tracks. If you are already in possession of a ticket to bauma no need to buy one, it is free. Alternatively, take exits terminals A or D for the Lufthansa airport bus, which departs for the 45 minute journey to Munich's main train station every 20 minutes from 06:25 to 21:45. Tickets cost €9.

To the show

BY TRAIN...

Both the U2 and U7 U-Bahn (underground) lines run to Messestadt West and Messestadt Ost stations at the bauma show grounds from Munich Central Station (Hauptbahnhof). Get off at the second exit (Ost) for the main cranes and access exhibits. Travel by train is free with your bauma pass.

Using the suburban railway, take either the S1 to Feldmoching and then switch to the U2 for a direct ride to the show ground, or the S8 to Ostbahnhof, switch to the U5 for the Innsbrucker Ring stop, and then onto the U2 or U7 to the show ground.

BY PLANE & BUS...

A regular shuttle service departs every 30 minutes from the airport for the New Munich Trade Fair Centre between 08:35 to 18:05. Tickets are €6 one-way or €10 return. At the airport, buses stop at Terminal 1 Module A, Terminal 1 Central Area and Terminal 2. The stop at the show is at the west entrance of the trade fair grounds.

BY CAR...

From the city of Munich, visitors should follow the bauma 2004 direction signs and electronic traffic control systems on the surrounding motorways, particularly on the main A 94 road, which has three exits for the show grounds.

In addition to the show grounds' own parking facilities, several decentralized parking locations are available around Munich city centre. Parking is free, and visitors can take public transport to and from bauma 2004 free of charge on presentation of admission or guest direct tickets.

UNTERWEGS ZUR MESSE MÜNCHEN

Flughafen

Die Taxifahrt vom Flughafen zum Messegelände gibt es zum Einheitspreis von 48 Euro. Sechs Euro (zehn hin- und zurück) kostet die Fahrt mit dem Bus, der alle 30 Minuten zwischen Flughafen und Messegelände pendelt.

Mit der U-Bahn vom Hauptbahnhof

Schneller gehts nicht: Mit der U-Bahn-Linie U2 erreichen Sie die Neue Messe München ICM vom Hauptbahnhof aus in weniger als 20 Minuten. Während der bauma fahren die U2 und die

Ergänzungslinie U7 zu den Hauptverkehrszeiten im Drei-Minuten-Takt zu den Haltestellen Messestadt West und Messestadt Ost.

Sie bekommen zusammen mit der bauma Eintrittskarte eine MVV-Messefahrkarte, die Sie schon zur Anreise nutzen können. Sie berechtigt zur kostenlosen Benutzung aller MVV-Verkehrsmittel im Gesamttarifgebiet für die Fahrt zum Messegelände und zurück. Sie gilt nur in Verbindung mit der gültigen Eintrittskarte. Ansonsten gibt es Einzel- und Streifenfahrkarten. Für alle Entfernungen innerhalb der Stadtgrenzen – so auch zur Neuen Messe – müssen Sie zwei Streifen am Automaten entwerfen.

Welcome Card.

Die Münchner Welcome Card – für einen oder für drei Tage – ermöglicht die freie Fahrt mit sämtlichen öffentlichen Verkehrsmitteln im Stadtgebiet und Ermäßigungen von bis zu 50 Prozent auf Sehenswürdigkeiten. Die Welcome Card kostet 6,50 beziehungsweise 16,00 Euro.

Verkehrsleitschilder zeigen im Großraum München den Weg zur neuen Messe. Auf dezentralen Parkplätzen können Sie gratis parken und mit Ihrer Eintrittskarte kostenlos die öffentlichen Verkehrsmittel zur Messe nutzen.
