We start this tour on the Manitowoc stand in the Gold Lot where you can check out Potain's largest flat-top/topless crane, the MCT 88 with its streamlined counter jib. Two versions are available with two or four part hooks, both of which can be rigged with jibs of up to 52 metres/171ft depending on the needs of the jobsite. The MCT 88 uses a standard 1.2 metre/3.9ft tower or 1.6 metre/5.2ft K masts. The maximum free standing height for the crane is 55 metres/179 ft. Do check out the new Potain full view cab and optional remote controls. Next stop is Liebherr which is also highlighting a flat top crane in the form of the 285 EC-B 12 Litronic. The crane top can



be completely pre-assembled including the moveable cab, switchgear cabinet, jib folding frame, slewing gear, slew ring and support and the current collector. Jib lengths are available up to 75

metres/248ft with a capacity at 70 metres of 3,150kg. For something smaller and faster the 81K is making its US debut, building on the success of the 71 K of which more than 1,000 units were sold. The 81K offers up to 25 percent better lift capacities and faster speeds.

Follow the perimeter to

Linden Comansa where you will find yet another flat top crane - from the originator of the concept – which is showing just the top of an 18 tonne 21 LC 550. However glance over your shoulder at the site of the new Fontainebleau Hotel and Casino and you will see several Comansa 21 LC 550 at work. Next head for Terex, possibly stopping off at the KNF stand where you might just find a regular hammerhead tower crane from the Korean producer. Continue



past JCB and onto the Terex stand to see another hammer-head - the 20 tonne Comedil Terex SK 415-20 tower crane. Equipped with the new EVO15 cab and new longer 80 metre/264ft jib at which radius the crane can handle 2.3 tonnes. A new HD23-TS212 transfer mast is available, which provides a free standing height of 91.6 metres/300ft. Last stop on this tour is to cross the main Lot to the Silver Lot to see Zoomlion.

Liebherr, donde también se destaca una grúa flat top en forma de 285 EC-B 12 Litronic. La parte superior de la grúa puede ser completamente pre-ensamblada incluyendo la cabina móvil, el armario de distribución, el marco plegable de pluma, el mecanismo de giro, la corona de giro y apoyo, y la corriente de colector.
